

**Entry to the Mic Morris Torfaen 2km Fun Run assumes that you are aware of, and agree to the following Terms and Conditions:-**

By participating in the Mic Morris Torfaen 2km Fun Run you acknowledge and agree that personal information can be stored and used by the Mic Morris Trust in connection with the organisation, promotion and administration of the event and for the compilation of statistical information.

By taking part, all participants confirm that their names and television and/or video footage or photographs taken during their participation may be used to publicise the Mic Morris Torfaen 2km Fun Run, and/or any other events hosted by the Mic Morris Trust.

All entry fees are non-refundable, and may not be deferred toward a future event.

Although on-line entries may close, there will be the opportunity to enter on the day IF our entry numbers have not been exceeded.

Participants must not be under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

**Event day**

Participants must follow instructions as given from all event officials including race staff and officials, volunteers, medical personnel, and security during and after the event.

**Children Under 8 years old must be accompanied by an adult.** Children over 8 years must be brought to the start and collected from the finish area.

All participants are expected to conduct themselves in a professional and courteous manner during their participation in the event. This means, for example, that urinating or defecating anywhere on or near the course shall be strictly prohibited except in toilet facilities. Anyone violating this rule of conduct shall be disqualified from the event and will be asked to leave the course.

Every participant will be provided with a race number, which **MUST** be worn on the **FRONT** of their shirt/vest and be visible at all times during the event.

Participants should also inform the race organisers in advance of the event of any special medical conditions.

Participants enter at their own risk, the Mic Morris Trust take no responsibility for illness, injury, loss or damage suffered by entrants.
